For: The reconstruction of 9,300 feet (approximately 1.8 miles) of CSAH 10 (Bass Lake Road) between 800 feet west of Peony Lane and 800 feet west of Vicksburg Lane/West Fish Lake Road, from a two-lane undivided rural facility to a four-lane divided urban roadway design. The project includes dedicated turn lanes at major intersections, bicycle/pedestrian trails on both sides of the roadway, and new signalized intersections to consolidate access.

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

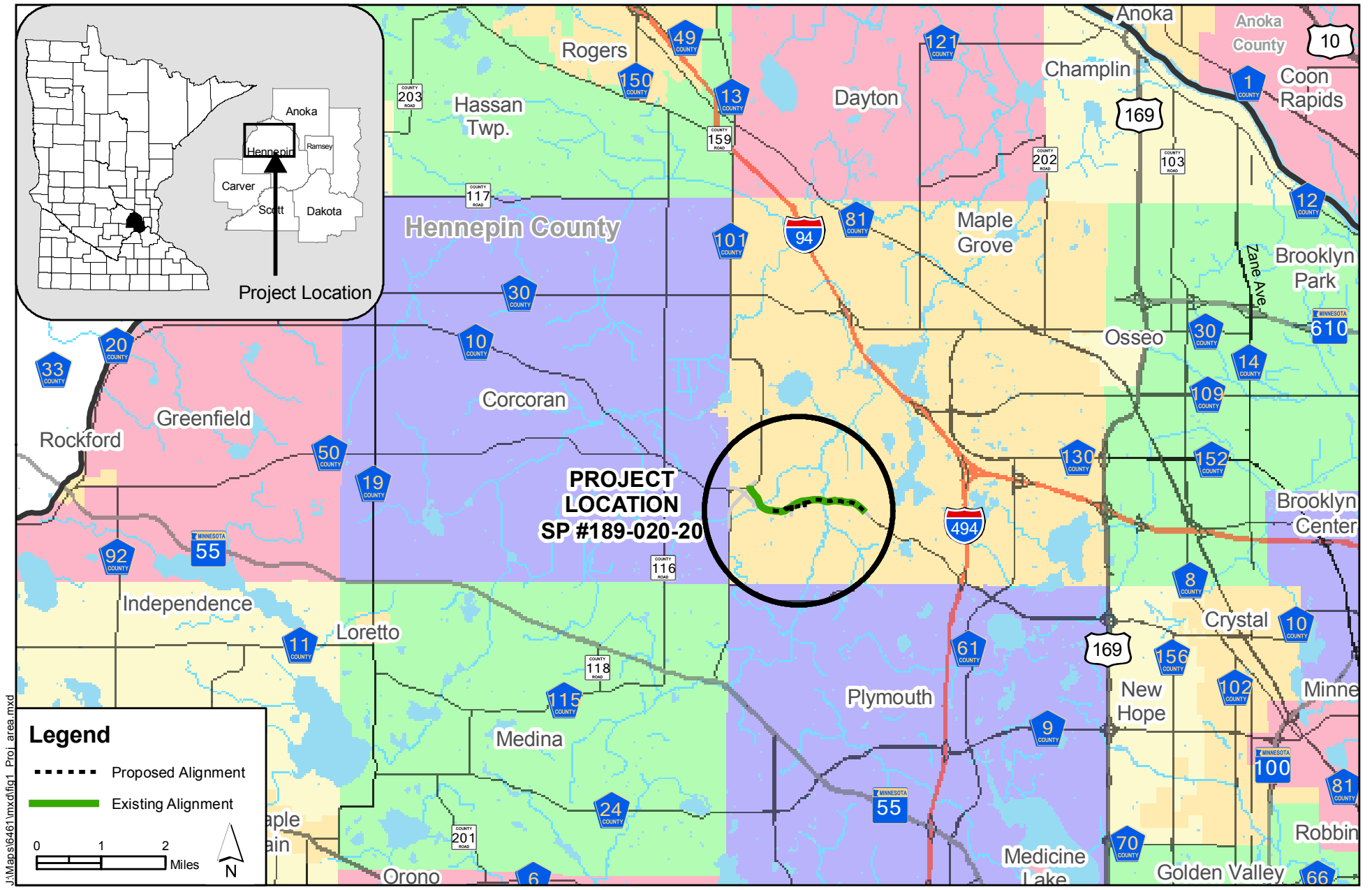

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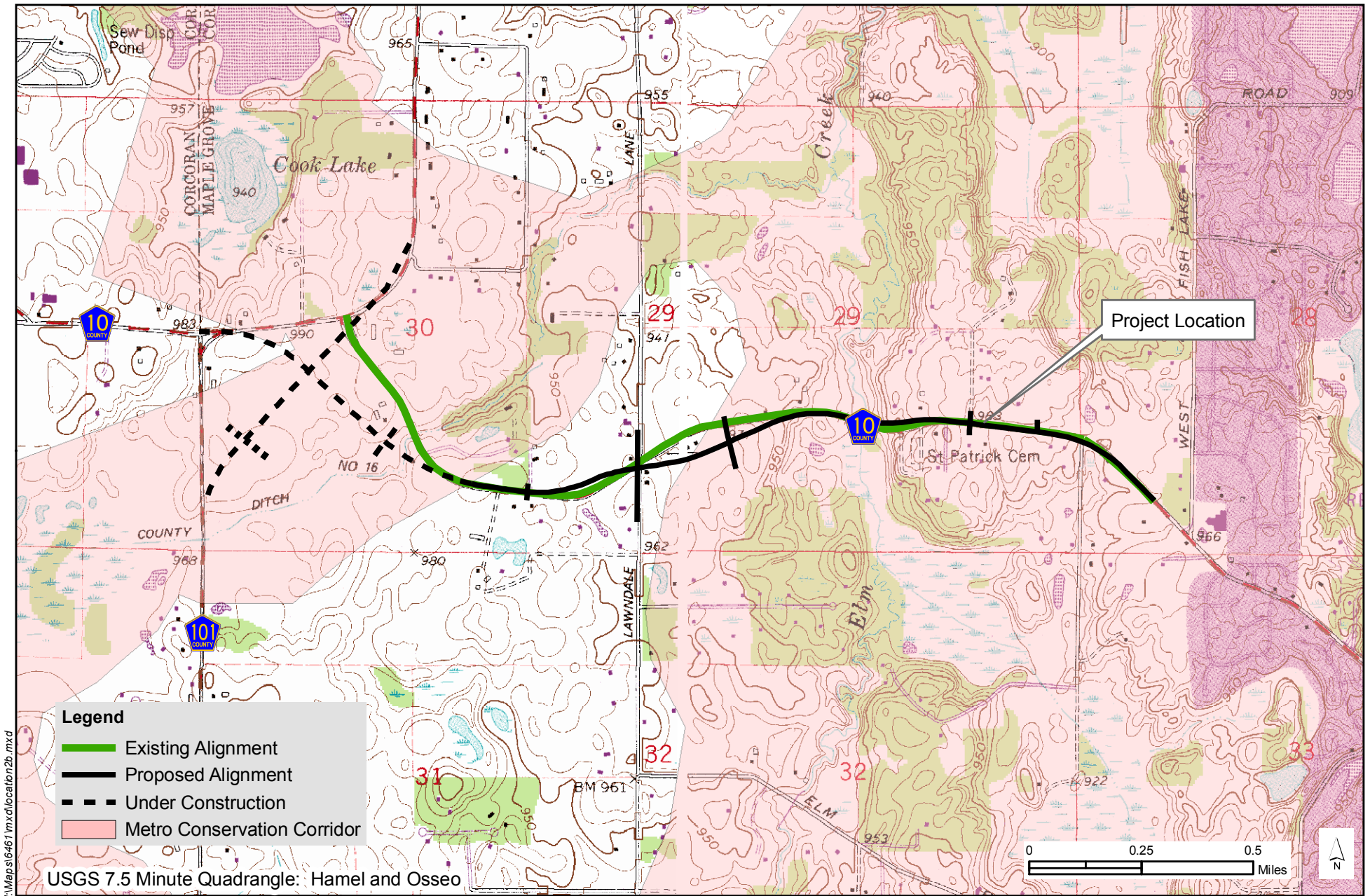
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Area Location

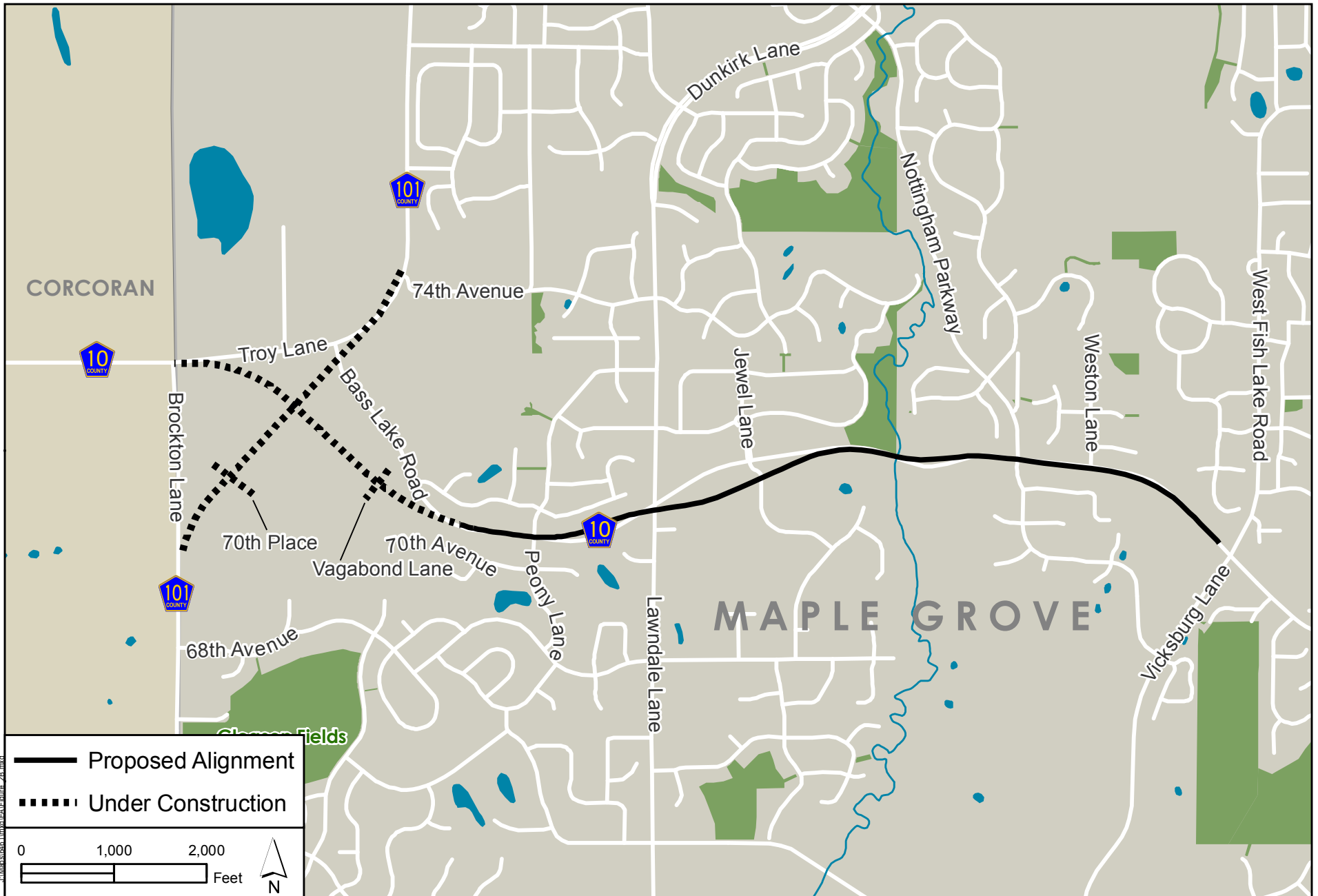

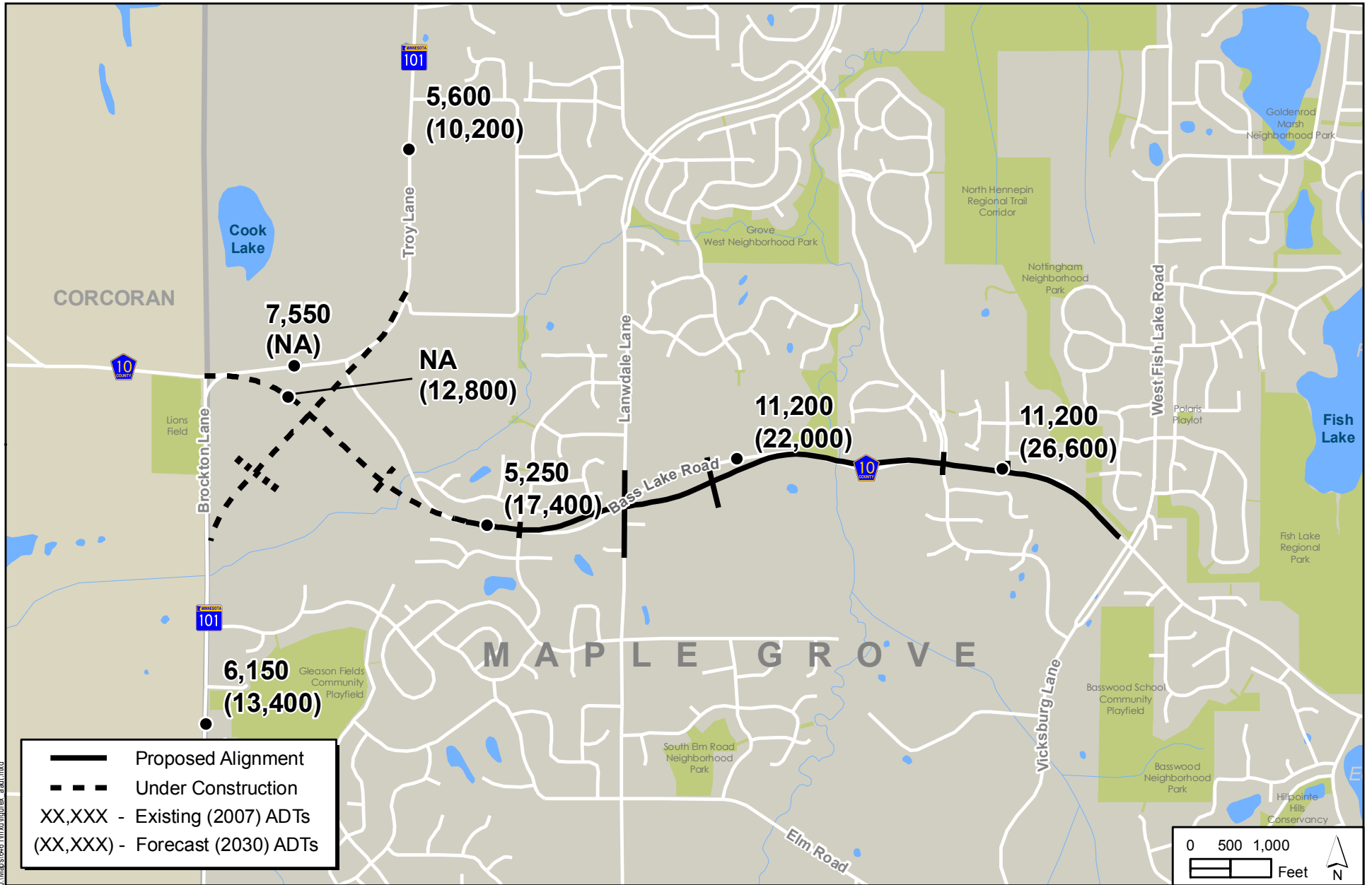
