Duties and Responsibilities of the “Special Inspection / Testing” Agency

1. Observe the work checked above to determine that it conforms with the *Approved* plans and specifications.
2. Furnish weekly observation/test reports to the City of Maple Grove Building Department.
3. Discrepancies or concerns shall be brought to the attention of the contractor’s designated representative; then if uncorrected, to the proper design authority and the Building Department.
4. Submit a final signed report stating whether the work requiring observation/testing was to the best of his/her knowledge, in conformance with the *Approved* plans and specifications.

Duties and Responsibilities of the General Contractor

1. Provide proper notification to the “Special Inspection/Testing” agency to observe/test the items checked above.
2. Comply with the recommendations of the “Special Inspection/Testing” agency’s representative and/or the appropriate registered designer.
3. Make available to the “Special Inspection/Testing” agency’s representative all *City Approved* plans, specifications, addenda and change orders.
