

LAWN IRRIGATION



This handout is intended only as a guide and is based in part on the 2007 Minnesota State Building Code, Maple Grove City ordinances, and good building practice. Maple Grove City Code Section 34-59. Lawn Sprinkler and Irrigation Systems

(a) Permit required. All lawn sprinkler systems and irrigation systems connected to the municipal water system, whether such systems are aboveground or underground, shall require a permit for connection and shall be installed in accordance with the Plumbing code adopted by reference in Chapter 8 Article II.

(b) Rain detection device. To conserve water, all lawn sprinkler systems and irrigation systems which are automatic or are equipped to operate automatically, whether installed before or after May 26, 1993, and which are connected to the municipal water system, shall be equipped with a rain-detection device such as the Mini Click II rain sensor manufactured by Glen Hilton Products or its equal so as to prevent the system from operating when it rains.
